Reporting to the Director of Artistic Swimming Programs (DASP), the ideal candidate is an enthusiastic leader that contributes to establishing team programs and assists in supervising, collaborating and mentoring both coaches and athletes. The Assistant Coach works with the Director of Artistic Swimming Programs (DASP) to lead in daily practices, establish team schedules, produce competition plans, assess swimmers and works to ensure that athlete performance plans are optimally implemented for both the competitive and recreational stream. Responsible for the safety and wellbeing of registered participants at all times, upholding the integrity of the club and ensuring that our club fosters a positive, productive and rewarding environment.
