

CANADIAN MASTERS 2025 QUOTA RULES

As mentioned last year, participation at all upcoming Masters National Championships will be subject to participation quotas. Because it is so difficult to forecast participation from year to year, and because of the multiple age groups, it's near impossible to set hard quotas at any point in time, so we will establish dynamic quotas that will work as follows:

TEAMS & COMBOS

- 1. All teams (free, technical, mixed ability & combo) will be accepted into Nationals as long as they have competed at their respective provincial Championships.
- 2. Exceptions may be granted upon requests in provinces where there are no such Championships, or for other reasons that would warrant a bye. Please send such requests to <u>stephane@artisticswimming.ca</u> before the registration deadline.

INDIVIDUAL ROUTINES

- 1. For all solos (tech & free, Adaptive), duets (tech, free, adaptive, mixed ability), mixed duets (tech, free, adaptive, mixed ability) and trios (tech, free, adaptive, mixed ability), the respective Provincial Championships results will be used to identify qualified routines.
- 2. The top 3 entries from each province in each age group will be automatically accepted into the competition.
- 3. Additional entries will be granted up to a maximum of 35 per event, as long as they can be placed in a schedule that ends no later than 10pm on May 9 and May 10, and 6pm on May 11.
- 4. Routines can only be entered at Canadian Championships in the same Age Group as in the Provincial Championships, including the "Open" category.
- 5. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to allow entry to only one program (tech or free) for a particular event if it results in wider participation in individual routines.

Please note that we ask that you register all your routines and we will let you know which ones have been accepted into the competition.
