The task area includes:

- athletic support of athletes at the base in Munich, mainly in the field of development and connection training (competition team)
- Conceptual and practical cooperation in the field of Bassin training, planning, implementation, control and monitoring of training and course measures as well as competitions for the athletes of the base
- Year-round support of the competition team of SG Stadtwerke München
- Responsibility for the sports students' synchronized swimming at the Elite School of Sports in Munich North
- Coordination of the services of the base for the squad athletes
- Participation in measures and trainings for talent assessment and Talent promotion in the BSV
- Close cooperation and coordination with club coaches, Base trainers, national coach, the BSV and the support point-bearing association
- Participation in the practices, further education and training of trainers - take over the organizational and administrative work of the area of responsibility. The task requires team and communication skills as well as social and pedagogical skills. Flexibility, resilience and high operational readiness (also on weekends) are expected. Independence, goal-oriented and conceptual work as well as very good task- and time management is necessary.

Special requirements are:

- DOSB Trainer A-license in the sport of synchronized swimming or at least B license with the readiness to acquire the A-license at the earliest possible date or equivalent international license



- Proof as lifeguard / in the level silver
- proven successes, especially in the introduction of young athletes to the national and international top
- possession of a valid driving license class B
- Good knowledge of German and / or English in spoken and written
- Experience in dealing with video and PC technology.

Employment is regularly 40 hours per week.

The remuneration for the trainer to be filled is by appointment.

The position is to be occupied until 31.12.2020.

An indefinite continued employment is sought.
