Venue Information

The competition will be held at Senzo Sporting Club

Address: Hurghada Safaga Road (only 10 minutes away from Hurghada International Airport and attached to Senzo Mall).
Competition pool: Outdoors (50mx25m), depth 2.5
Warm-up pool: open air

Athletes Medical Services

Medical service will be available during the stay of the teams in Hurghada, it will be available at training and competition facilities. Mobile medical teams and an ambulance team will be working at the competition venue near competition zone. If the patient is in need of emergency medical care, he is taken to the city Clinic of Hurghada on duty (5 minutes far from competition venue).

Technical Officials

Every participating NF must bring a minimum of one A or G FINA judge and a maximum of two to every meet they enter. An A judge will be given priority over G judges and all FINA judges must have successfully passed the Judges Exam administered at a FINA Artistic Swimming Judges Certification in School in 2018, and the 2019 on line exam and be on the current FINA List.

Practice judges are accepted at all events of the Series, maximum one judge per Federation.

Neutral Judges: Neutral Judges are invited to apply to the OC to attend World Series. In the event of low foreign participation in a ASWS Leg FINA may appoint one (1) or two (2) neutral judges to ensure a balance between the judges' nationalities. National Federation judges may be used if they have FINA status or have passed the Advanced Exam.

Music

The music (competition + gala) must be submitted electronically via internet before Feb 27, 2020 by e-mail: <u>OC_Hurghada2020@esf-eg.org</u>

Each submission shall be labeled as to event, name of the national federation and name of the competitors (for example Duet_Tech_RUS_Name).

Please note that you still have to bring with you your music on a USB stick or a CD.



Accreditation

All National Federations must be registered in the GMS by the deadline. No extra forms are needed.

Rules

As event of FINA AS World Series, the competition will be organized according to FINA ASWS Regulations. Category: Senior Routines: Technical Routines (Solo, Mixed Duet, Duet and Team) and Free Routines (Solo, Mixed Duet, Duet, Team, Combination and Highlight). The events are to be held separately and the results cannot be combined.

Entries

Every National Federation competing in the World Series is requested to register its athletes through the FINA GMS. Should a National Federation enter several solos, duets, mixed duets or team events with members of their national delegation, only the highest ranked solos, duets, mixed duets or team in each event will be considered for the Series' results and rankings. The National Federations may enter different athletes in the solo, duet, mixed duet and team events of the various legs of the Series they wish to take part in. (2020 Rules and Regulations)

For this competition: every national federation may enter 2 solo, 2 duets, 2 mixed duets, 1 team, 1 combination and 1 highlight in either the Technical and/or the Free events. Athletes may be different for the technical and the Free events.

Finals: direct for all events (without Preliminaries).

Time limits: according to FINA Rules (AS 14).

Draws (at Team Leaders meeting on March 26, 2020): according to FINA Rules (AS 13.7)

Ceremonies & Sport Presentation

Swimmers must wear the team uniform.

1. Opening Ceremony: March 27 (Friday) All swimmers shall assemble in a designated area for an official parade.

2. Medal Ceremony: Swimmers who place 1st to 3rd shall assemble in the designated area to prepare for the Medals.

1st-3rd place of each event shall be awarded respectively. In case more than one entry per nation swim the routine, only one team per nation will be awarded on the podium and will receive a medal.





- Sport Presentation: each National Federation should inform on the following:
 - Music Choice
 - Theme
 - Name of athlete and interesting facts about them and their goals.
 - Name of Coach and interesting fact about the coach (e.g. how long the coach and athlete have been together)
- Gala:

The Gala will take place after the final award ceremony. Later on, a farewell outing hosting all athletes and officials will take place on one of the famed Islands of Hurghada.
