Bylaw 1

MOTION: THAT Canada Artistic Swimming bylaw 16.1 read that the Board of Canada Artistic Swimming shall consist of a minimum of five and a maximum of seven Directors-at-large, elected at the Annual Meeting.

MOTION: THAT Canada Artistic Swimming bylaw 16.7 read no more than three Directors may be elected each year to three-year terms

Bylaw 3

MOTION: THAT CAS bylaw 16.12 read Other than as described in Section 17 and Section 19 below, no Director may serve more than nine years as a Director in his or her lifetime.

It was explained that no director is given an automatic 9 years – the peer review is a process that will continue to provide feedback to board members and directors will continue to run for election. It was suggested that nine years gives individuals more time to accomplish objectives, gives the organization more stability at the board table, and possibly allows directors time for a break between terms if they desire. It was noted that it will take until 2020 for all directors to be on 3 year terms.
