We offer high quality Recreational and Competitive artistic swimming programs to athletes of all ages, from those just starting out to highly trained Masters athletes who compete internationally.

We are looking for coaches at all levels from Recreational and Athletes with Diverse Abilities, to Competitive and Masters Competitive.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Design and Implement coaching plans appropriate to the level/program
- Provide on deck coaching for your athletes during regular weekly training, competitions as applicable, club and other events (such as Water Shows).
- Provide constructive feedback and communication to your swimmers as needed
- Plan and implement routine theme and choreography
- Provide other coaching as needed and if possible, as well as other assistance to deliver high quality programming to your athletes

Secondary Responsibilities:

- Attend regular coach meetings and regularly communicate with the Head Coach about athlete/training needs
- Provide regular communication to parents of athletes as appropriate
- Supervise and assist other athletes during competitive weekends as agreed upon and if applicable to the program
- Maintain athlete and training records.

Qualifications:

- Current Canada Artistic Swimming training and/or certification applicable to the program, eg. AquaGO, Comp-Intro, Comp-Dev
- Previous Artistic Swimming coaching experience AND/OR previous or current artistic swimming experience
- In good standing with CAS + current provincial sport organization.
- Ideal candidates will have NLS and/or other advanced lifeguard training.
- Excellent organization and communication skills

Locations and Hours:

TASC trains at a number of different locations depending on the program, largely in central/midtown Toronto. Hours are to be determined by the club's coaching needs and the availability of individual coaches, can vary from between 90 mins week (1x Recreational group) to over 14 hours per week (Competitive team coaching + extra routines/training). Our club works very hard to accommodate the needs and availability of coaches since all/most are either in school or working full time.

Rate of Pay: Based on role, qualifications and experience of individual coaches. TASC offers competitive wages and other pay (eg. meet pay, travel and/or coach development reimbursement).
